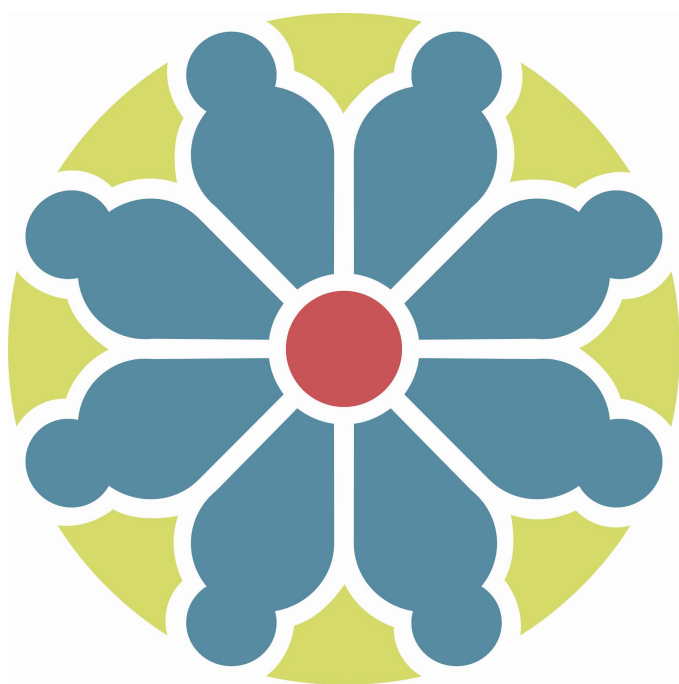

### NOTIFICATION & REGISTRATION

This “What to Expect” document is designed to provide details and guidance as we Re-Emerge for onsite service at Bradley United Methodist church. Worshippers are asked to register their intentions to attend the Worship Service through online registration or by calling the church office at 317-462-2662. Check the church website or Facebook page the week before the service for specific details and a registration site link.

### HEALTH & SAFETY

Individuals will be asked to attend on-site worship when healthy and without a fever. All worshippers, including children over the age of two, will be required to wear a mask while inside the Church. Masks will be available at the church entrance for those who do not bring their own face covering.

### ENTRY

For social distancing purposes, the West entrance will be the primary entrance in the Re-Emerge Plan. Only those individuals who require the accessibility of the Main Street entrance will be directed to use that entrance.

Greeters will be stationed in BUMC church parking lots, sidewalks around the church, and at the entrances to welcome, assist and remind worshippers to maintain social distancing and to direct them to the proper entrances.

Signage throughout the building will provide reminders and guidelines.

## INTERIOR SAFETY PRACTICES

Hand sanitizing stations will be located inside the West Entrance and the Main Street Narthex. Staff will ensure everyone maintains appropriate social distancing while moving to the Sanctuary.

All loose items will be removed from the worship pews and seating areas. Loose items include, but are not limited to, hymnals, Bibles, pens/pencils, tissues, and attendance pads. There will be no print bulletins or children's materials. Families are encouraged to bring their own activity materials for children.

The restroom, located behind the sanctuary area, will be available for use. Ushers will wipe high-touch areas after each use.

Measures will be taken to ensure the Sanctuary is properly cleaned and prepared for use the following Sunday.

## SANCTUARY PRACTICES

Worshippers, by individual/family group, will be guided to seating by an usher to assure social distancing. Pews will be clearly marked as either available or not available for seating. There will be a minimum of 6 feet of space between each seating area available for each family/group.

All those seated in the Chancel area will be at least 6 feet apart at all times and will use separate microphones.

At the conclusion of the service, ushers will dismiss worshippers to ensure proper social distancing while encouraging everyone to move directly to the designated exit(s).

## COMMUNION PRACTICES

Individual, disposable single-serve communion packets will be used for Holy Communion.

## ADDITIONAL SUNDAY MORNING SERVICES

Until further notice, the following services will not be available on Sunday mornings:

- Nursery (the nursery room will be available as a "cry room")
- Fellowship Time (no food/drink available)
- Sunday School
- Choir
